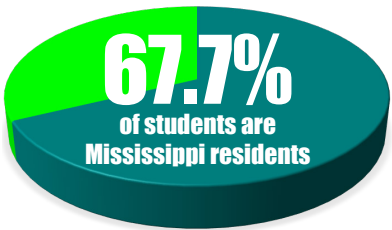

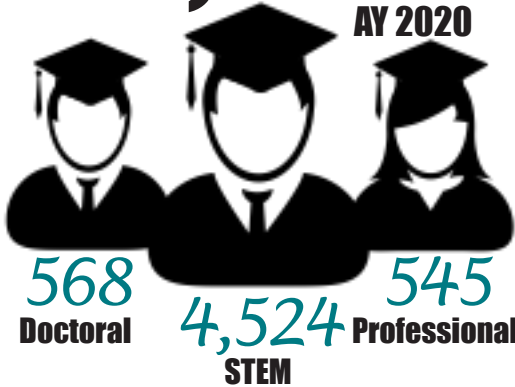

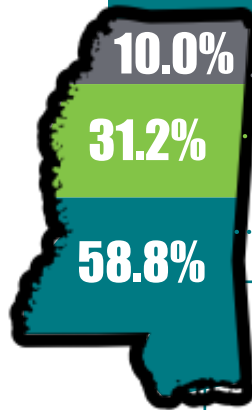

Alcorn State University School of Nursing's graduate program now offers its first doctoral degree, Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP), in addition to its Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) degree.



Delta State University's new Digital Media Arts program is the only program in the state to offer an animation concentration, preparing graduates for careers in the rapidly growing fields of motion graphics, video production, sound design and photography.



Jackson State University is accredited by AACSB International, an honor only six percent of business schools worldwide earn, and JSU is only one of two HBCUs in the country that offers a Ph.D. program in accounting.



Mississippi State University offers the state's only petroleum engineering degree program in response to a high demand from industry for graduates with experience in drilling, production, petroleum economics and reservoir engineering.



The **Mississippi State University Extension Service** served almost 713,000 direct contacts and safely delivered nearly 3,000 local programs, totaling more than 4 million impacts on Mississippians.



Mississippi University for Women's RN to BSN program has been consistently ranked as one of the top hybrid-online and campus-based classroom experiences in the nation.



Mississippi Valley State University offers the state's only master's degree in Bioinformatics. It's a multi-disciplinary program in molecular biology, computer science, and mathematics.



The **University of Mississippi's** Center for Manufacturing Excellence produces graduates who are leaders & innovators of modern manufacturing and cultivates partnerships with leading companies including Ingalls Shipbuilding, Nissan, and Toyota.



The **University of Mississippi Medical Center** is designated a Telehealth Center of Excellence as recognized by the federal Health Resources and Services Administration, one of two institutions nationally that hold this distinction.



The **University of Southern Mississippi's** annual economic impact on the state of Mississippi is more than \$600 million, and the University creates and supports nearly 6,000 jobs in Hattiesburg and more than 1,250 on the Gulf Coast.
